



## ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) CREDIT FOR 2007 EXAMS

Course and/or free elective credit is based on exam scores received. AP exams passed with a score of 3 or higher will earn up to eight (8) units of semester credit. Exams passed earn a grade of credit (CR) and are not calculated into the GPA. Extension of credit is reviewed annually, and occasionally varies from exam year to exam year, as content, exams and Channel Islands curricula are subject to change.
