Mission:

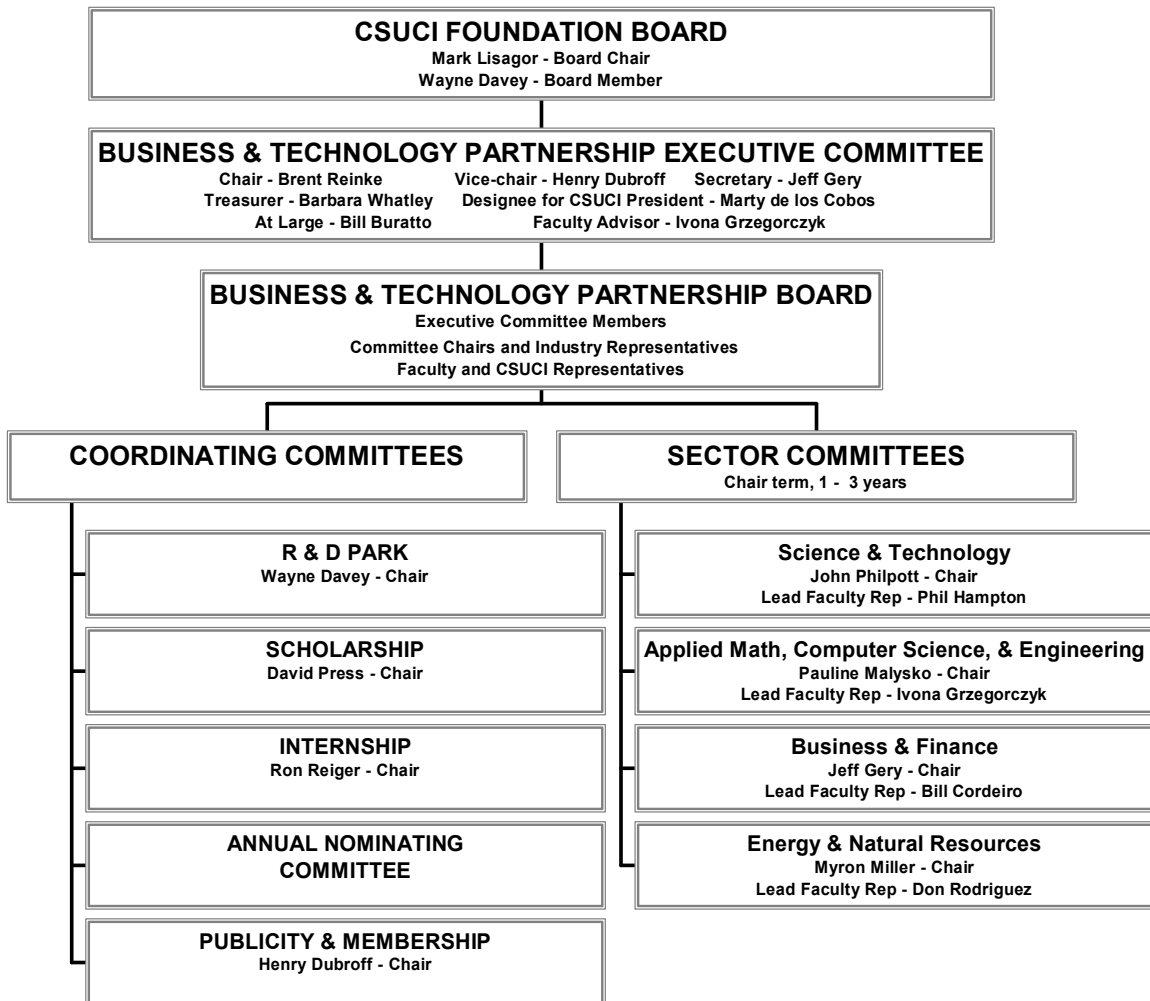
To foster the collaboration of technology-based and related service based companies with CSUCI and to promote technological excellence among its students, faculty, and staff for the benefit of the region's economy.
